Title: SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY CHANGES

Summary: An Act to Provide that a Person Required to Register Pursuant to the Sex Offender and Public Protection Registration Programs Must Also Report in Person to and Notify the Appropriate Sheriff of the Address of Any Temporary Residences Maintained by the Registrant, to Include Additional Locations in the List of Protected Properties Where Certain Sex Offenders are not Allowed to be on the Premises or are Allowed to be on the Premises Only in Certain Circumstances, to Provide that the Restrictions Prohibiting the Presence of Certain Sex Offenders on Certain Properties Frequented by Minors Also Apply to Any Out-Of-State Person Who Comes into North Carolina If the Out-Of-State Person is Required to Register in Another State Under the Registration Laws of that State for an Offense Similar to One in North Carolina that Prohibits the Offender's Presence on the Protected Property, and to Make Various Conforming Changes to the Sex Offender and Public Protection Registration Statutes.
