Summary: An Act to Direct the State Board of Education to Develop Guidelines for Public Schools to Use Evidence-Based Fitness Testing for Students Statewide in Grades Kindergarten Through Eight, as Recommended by the Legislative Task Force on Childhood Obesity.

Summary: An Act to Direct the Division of Social Services of the Department of Health and Human Services to Examine Ways to Expand and Enhance the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program in North Carolina, as Recommended by the Legislative Task Force on Childhood Obesity.

Title: EXTEND EMERGENCY FORECLOSURE PROGRAM

Summary: An Act to Amend and Extend the Emergency Program to Reduce Home Foreclosures Act, to Increase and Authorize Fees Under the S.A.F.E. Mortgage Licensing Act, and to Revise the Definition of Certain Terms in the Predatory Lending Law.

Title: IMPROVE CHILD CARE NUTRITION/ACTIVITY STNDS

Summary: An Act to Require the Child Care Commission, in Consultation with the Division of Child Development of the Department of Health and Human Services, to Develop Improved Nutrition Standards for Child Care Facilities, to Direct the Division of Child Development to Study and Recommend Guidelines for Increased Levels of Physical Activity in Child Care Facilities, and to Direct the Division of Public Health to Work with Other Entities to Examine and Make Recommendations for Improving Nutrition Standards in Child Care Facilities.

Summary: An Act to Require All Early Care and Education Providers Working in Licensed Child Care Centers or Licensed Family Child Care Homes to Obtain and Maintain Early Educator Certification.

Summary: An Act to Restore a Balance to the Law on Unemployment Compensation for Substitute Teachers as Recommended by the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee.

Title: CORP. PUNISH. FOR CHILDREN W/DISABILIT

Summary: An Act to Prohibit the Use of Corporal Punishment on a Student with a Disability as Defined in G.S. 115c-106.3(1) or Section 504 of the Federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973 Whose Parent or Guardian Has Stated in Writing that Corporal Punishment Shall not be Administered on that Student, and to Require Local Boards of Education to Report Occurrences of Corporal Punishment to the State Board of Education.

Title: FOUR-YEAR COHORT GRADUATION RATE

Summary: An Act to Direct the State Board of Education to Develop a Growth Model for Establishing Short-Term Annual Goals for Improving the Four-Year Cohort Graduation Rate, to Establish a Long-Term Goal of Increasing the Statewide Four-Year Cohort Graduation Rate, and to Allow Military Dependents Whose Parents are Deployed to Attend School Before the Age of Five in North Carolina If Eligible in the State Where the Child's Parent is Permanently Stationed.

Title: EARLY IDENTIF. & INTERV. FOR AT-RISK STUDENTS

Summary: An Act to Require Local School Administrative Units to Identify Students at Risk of Academic Failure and not Successfully Progressing Toward Graduation No Later Than the Fourth Grade, to Provide Personal Education Plans for Those Students, to Require Local School Administrative Units to Certify Compliance Annually to the State Board of Education, and to Require the State Board of Education to Periodically Review Data on the Progress of Identified Students and Report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee.
